



# Essentiality Certificate Issuing Process at DGH



#### **Notification**



 Essentiality Certificate issued by DGH is as per Notification No 12/2012-Cus dated -17/03/2012 and further amendments from time to time, S No 357 & 357A for custom duty free import of material required for petroleum operations.

DSF round operators have to apply in subsection "Marginal Field",
which is S No. 357A(d).



#### Notification....Cont.



Operator can take materials from other operators in India by obtaining NOC from DGH.

• For indigenous purchase PAC is issued as per notification no. 12/2012-CE, s no 336.





- Operator applies for Authorized signatory.
- Authorized signatory is approved at DGH.
- Authorized signatory then applies EC online in ECMS system.
- Uploads all the relevant documents in the system.
- Authorized signatory signs all the documents and submit hard copy at DGH.



#### The Process.....Cont.



- EC application is processed at DGH by Nodal officer, Technical officer and then by EC officer.
- If found in order IA (Issuing Authority) issues the certificate in case of goods value less than or equal to 2 cr.
- DG makes the Final Approval in case of goods value greater than 2 crores and returns back to IA. IA (Issuing Authority) issues the certificate.



#### The Certificate



• The certificate issued by DGH is submitted at customs while filing Bill of Entry for getting waiver of custom duty as per notification.

and

 The PAC certificate issued by DGH is submitted to excise for getting excise duty waiver as per notification.
