

**ENGAGEMENT OF APPRENTICES IN LEGAL DEPARTMENT UNDER APPRENTICES ACT,  
1961 (as amended)**

Directorate General of Hydrocarbons invites applications from recently passed out Law graduates for engagement as Apprentices (Legal) under Apprentices Act, 1961 (as amended) for apprenticeship training in its Noida office for a period of one year.

**Number of training slots: 02**

**Essential Educational qualification:**

Law graduates, with Govt./BCI/ UGC recognized LLB degree (3 years' Professional Course) or Integrated LLB of 5 years in First Division (60% or more aggregate marks of all semesters), Passed out in 2022 or after, from reputed Universities of India, may apply with requisite details latest by 11.03.2024 on the website: [www.apprenticeshipindia.org](http://www.apprenticeshipindia.org).

**Stipend:** Monthly stipend Rs. 45,000/- plus Rs. 2,000/- as monthly communication allowance and Rs. 3,000/- monthly as conveyance allowance will be paid to the apprenticeship trainees.

**Duration of Training period:** One year

Candidates meeting the above eligibility criteria and medically fit as per the provisions of the Apprenticeship Act, 1961 (as amended) are eligible to apply.

**Candidates are not eligible to apply for apprenticeship in following cases:**

- (1) Awaiting the result of their final examination of LLB degree course
- (2) Not completed age of 18 years
- (3) Undergone apprenticeship training in Legal discipline in any other organization
- (4) Work experience of more than one year on the last date of receipt of application

**Selection Process:** The eligible applicants would be called for Online Personal Interview and their final selection would be based on their performance in the Interview.
