- 9. Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

A. INTRODUCTION

Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH) is an upstream advisory & technical arm under Administrative control of the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas to promote sound management of the Indian petroleum and natural gas resources. Its Office is located at Tower A, OIDB Bhawan, Sector - 73, Noida (UP).

Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH) has been assigned responsibility to host a comprehensive monitoring solution for resolution of issues and mitigating delay in clearances in line with the format of Project PRAGATI being used by PMO. To achieve the intended objective as above, a comprehensive monitoring solution, including a Multi-Point Video Conferencing solution and web-based solution to be hosted on NIC Cloud id proposed to be implemented on priority. The web-based platform, to be termed as "Petro Pragati" will be used at topmost levels of Hon'ble Minister, MoP&NG, Secretary, MoP&NG & Empowered Cabinet Committee besides being used by DG/ADG at DGH.

B. SINGLE POINT RESPONSIBILITY FOR EXECUTION OF ENTIRE PROJECT

Through the MCU and Video Conferencing Solution envisaged in this tender, DGH desires to present a superior online collaborative experience to the users during VC Sessions, Web Meetings and during local presentations inside a Conference Hall. To fix single point responsibility, complete project will be awarded to same bidder. The winning bidder will have to take single point responsibility on turnkey basis to execute the entire scope of work comprising of Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning & Maintenance of the audio-visual equipment along with associated control systems as per DGH's requirement & technical specifications mentioned in this tender. The solution must include package of fully integrated solution including the complete hardware, software, networking, audio visual, conferencing & control systems.

C. FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENT & BIDDER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1) The vendor is required to supply complete MCU based Video Conferencing solution as per BOQ and attached specifications.
- 2) The vendor will be responsible for installation and commissioning of the supplied Hardware and making them fully operational to achieve the following:
- a) The supplied VC equipment should have capability to show VC output on the existing TV / display devices in Full-HD mode. Presentation can be presented in HD/VGA mode from any of the presentation points and which needs to be integrated as content share in VC. Vendor should ensure Integration of supplied VC equipment's with existing equipment's like TV display and presentation point etc.
- 3) The supplied VC equipment should have capability to show VC output on the existing TV / display devices in Full-HD mode. Presentation can be presented in HD/VGA mode from any of the presentation points and which needs to be integrated as content share in VC. Vendor should ensure Integration of supplied VC equipment's with existing equipment's like TV display and presentation point etc.
- 4) The Installation of MCU based Video Conferencing Solution consist of Installation, Configuration and Commissioning of MCU, Gatekeeper, Firewall traversal Device, management Server, Browser based Video Conferencing Solution and Recording and Streaming Solution.
- 5) The Complete MCU based Video Conferencing Solution including MCU, Gatekeeper, Management Server, Firewall Traversal, Recording & Streaming and Browser based VC is to be installed DGH, Noida.
- 6) The complete MCU based Video Conferencing solution is also required to be integrated with existing Video Conferencing devices available with DGH.
 - a) Polycom Real Presence Group Series
 - b) Polycom HDX Series
- 7) The vendor is required to provide and configure all software up gradations or firmware updates from time to time. All system software will be licensed to DGH. as per terms of licenses. All updates for the license software should be provided as per terms of licenses.
- 8) Fine tune the VC Infrastructure to join Video Conferencing over Intranet and internet.
- 9) Submission of following manuals after installation and configuration:
 - a) Configuration Document
 - b) Administration Manual for L3 support
 - c) User Manual
- 10) The overall system shall be handed over to the satisfaction of the purchaser after successful User Acceptance Test (UAT) as per terms of the contract.
- 11) The installation, configuration and implementation of the MCU based Video Conferencing infrastructure should be done by the OEM directly.
- 12) The OEM engineer carrying out the configuration and implementation should carry an identity card to show that he/she is an employee of the OEM.
- 13) The vendor has to ensure complete end to end functionality of Multipoint Conferencing Unit through VC connectivity with internal users, external users and mobile users. The vendor has to demonstrate all the functionalities and features of MCU based VC solution as per requirements mentioned in specifications and scope of work.
- 14) The Vendor will prepare and submit the Installation Report mentioning complete details of MCU and other Equipment's including serial no. after completion of work.
- 15) All jobs, whether mentioned explicitly in this tender document or not, but required during installation shall be the total responsibility of the successful bidder.
- 16) Any other items (Equipment, Hardware / Software or licenses) required to make system fully operational, not specifically mentioned in BOQ will also be in the scope of the bidder.

D. PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The following Criteria should be meet by the Vendor, failing which the bid shall not be accepted:

- 1) The bidder, during last Three years, must have successfully carried out and completed three similar work.
- 2) The bidder should not have been banned from participating in tenders or on holiday list / black list at the time of bidding by any of the Government of India Institute / State Government organization / Pubic Sector organization.
- 3) The bidder should be an authorized partner and system integrator of OEM. The bidder should submit valid authorization certificate from the OEM along with the bid to participate in this tender.
- 4) The Bidder must have own office in NCR (Gurgaon/ Delhi/ Noida/ Faridabad/ Ghaziabad) for sale and support. Bidder has to provide the complete address along with telephone number. Bidder must provide list of service/support engineer working in that office. Details of experience of service and support engineer handling similar nature of jobs as defined in tender documents to be provided.

E. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

The products to be supplied must meet the minimum specifications mentioned in the bid document. However, it will be the responsibility of the bidder to quote products with higher specifications, if required, to deliver a glitch free experience for the intended integrated solution during commissioning. Also, the bidder will be required to provide free of cost & install all such items/ products that are not explicitly mentioned in the tender/ quoted by the bidder, but are essential to deliver integrated solutions as per requirement. These will include items that are discovered necessary at the time of commissioning of the solution.

F. SPECIAL TERMS AND CONIDITIONS

The following are the Special Terms and Conditions for the proposed job:

- 1) The specifications for devices are indicative of minimum requirement. Better specifications /models shall also be considered. The offer must contain detailed technical specifications, technical literature/brochures of the make and model offered.
- 2) The vendor shall submit all the necessary documents/brochures etc. for the quoted equipment along with the offer. All internet documents shall be treated as valid.
- 3) The devices shall be under comprehensive on-site warranty for a period of 3 (Three) years from the date of installation. Bidders shall submit the proof of same from OEM along with installation report.
- 4) The bidder is required to provide Software upgradations from time to time. All system software will be licensed to Directorate General of Hydrocarbons as per terms of licenses. All updates for the license software should be provided as per terms of licenses.
- 5) The offer must clearly comply and confirm (Yes/No) against each and every specification. The exact specification offered must also be specified clearly.
- 6) During warranty period, the successful bidder will be responsible for smooth running of device and will take corrective action whenever required.
- 7) The vendor will guarantee that all the material to be supplied is brand new, original including all components.
- 8) Maintenance (during Warranty Period): Breakdown Maintenance: In case of any breakdown the vendor shall be intimated by fax, e-Mail or phone.
- 9) The successful bidder may be asked to relocate the installed device to another place and reconfigure within the Server Room of the respective location. The job is to be carried out with no additional charges to Directorate General of Hydrocarbons.
- 10) Any additional hardware/license/cables etc. required to implement the solution, vendor should provide the same without any extra cost to Directorate General of Hydrocarbons.
- 11) Supply, installation, commissioning and testing of IT hardware/ materials/ complete solution (mentioned

in the bid document) should be completed within 60 days from the date of award of contract.

12) Payment will be made within 15 days after successful supply, installation and commissioning/ testing of the complete solution and on submission of invoice and requisite certificate/ documents.

- 13) Payment Payment for Resident Engineer cost will be made after each completed quarter on the basis of Invoice submitted and Preventive Maintenance Report by Vendor. Penalty deductions if any for that quarter shall be deducted from the payment of said quarter.
- 14) The normal working hours for resident engineer will be Monday to Friday from 09:30 hrs. to 18:00 hrs. In case of urgent requirement, the resident engineer shall render the services beyond the normal working hours/working days without any extra charges.
- 15) Continuous manning of Resident Engineer has to be ensured i.e. posting of another engineer in case the incumbent engineer is on leave, training, sickness etc. The engineer shall strictly follow the DGH holiday calendar. In case of leave of Resident Engineer, prior approval of DGH is mandatory. However in case of absence/leave without any reliever penalty will be imposed as per 1.5 times per day cost of support Engineer and the same will be deducted from the ensuing quarterly bill against charges for Resident Engineer.
- 16) The Maintenance / repair work shall be carried-out, as & when required/advised, through Skilled/trained/Experienced technician only. Technician must carry Mobile Phone all the time for smooth communication. Repairs / Maintenance works shall be carried out normally during working days; however in exigencies, as directed by Directorate General of Hydrocarbons, work may be required to be attended during odd hours/ holidays/ off-days at no extra cost. The Site shall be cleared / cleaned after the execution of work.
- 17) The Resident Engineer may be required to do IT Support job in addition to the Upkeep and maintenance of Offered VC and MCU setup.
- 18) The Contractor shall be prepared to provide the service odd hours/ holidays/ off-days, if so directed by the Engineer-in-Charge. No claim for any compensation or extra payment, whatsoever on this account, shall be entertained.
- 19) The Contractor would ensure that deputed Engineer by him do behave courteously and decently with the employees of the Directorate General of Hydrocarbons and also ensure good manners.
- 20) The Contractor shall ensure the Safety and Insurance of deputed Engineer attending the Repair / Maintenance job at site.
- 21) All the Preventive Maintenance on Bidder part has to be happen on working days or off-days i.e. preferably on Monday to Saturday with prior approval of DGH. In case of emergency maintenance on other days, work can be carried out only with special approval of DGH. Downtime for Pre-approved preventive maintenance jobs shall not be considered for calculation of downtime.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization.
