Clause B.1, 2.0 (vi) of Annexure II (Bid Rejection/Ev aluation Criteria)	Clause B.1(vi) of Annexure II of the Tender, provides that: "Bidders should not be associated directly or indirectly with rival contractor/agency or any person/entity against MoPNG in disputes during the last 5 (five) years as on the Bid closing date. *An undertaking in Company's Letter head must be provided by the bidder confirming the above." In relation to the above, please note that the above Bid Rejection/Evaluation criteria appears to be onerous in nature, as most Tier 1 law firms specializing/working in the Oil & Gas Sector would have multiple private sector clients and may be advising/have advised and/or are engaged (in the last 5 (five) years) on matters where the counterparty may by the MoPNG, directly or indirectly. Accordingly, given the broad ambit of the bid criteria, various law firms will be automatically be disqualified which would limit open participation in the Tender bidding process and will restrict competition/participation.
